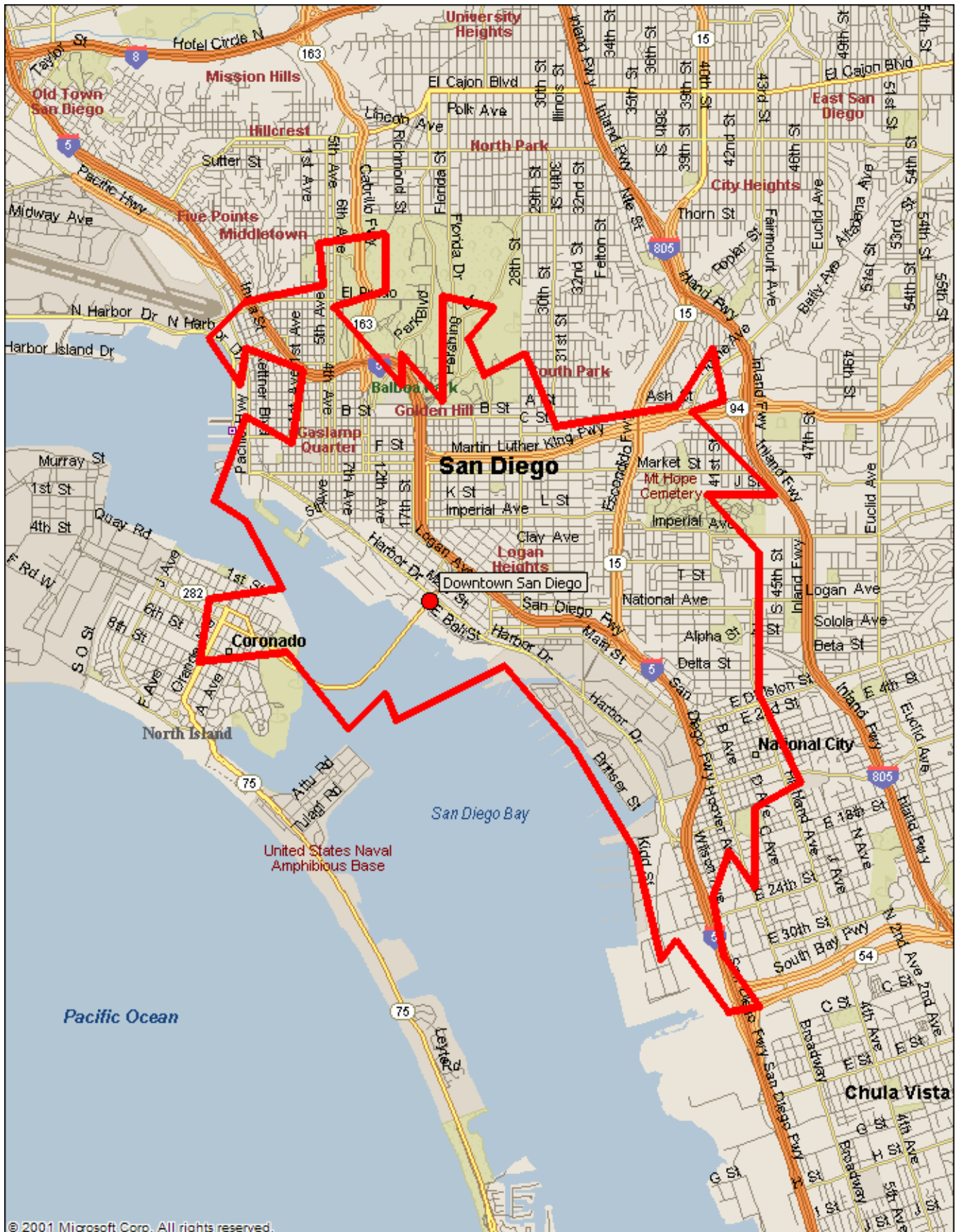


Downtown San Diego, CA 10 minute Drive Time
